#### What is coworking

Coworking at The Cluster is a shared collaborative workspace for professionals. It's based on the belief that we are more productive and creative when we work together than alone.

#### Did I hear something about free food?

The Cluster provides free Tea/Coffee, bread, spreads and various other snacks for you to enjoy during your working week!
